1. What did you learn about the topic? Summarize!

2. List all the people involved with the topic (if there are any).

3. Who will be your box sender? Why are they sending the box?

4. Who is receiving the box? How do they feel about it? Why?

5. What's the setting? Where is the box being opened? Why?

6. What would the sender write in a note inside the box?

7. What items might be in the box? How does that show what you've learned?

Now, let's plan out this unboxing video!



PRE-RECORD: What items should I gather? What box will you use? Where will you record it to create the setting? Lighting: dark, bright, spotlight? Will you include music?* How will you set up your camera? Do a practice recording to make sure your audio is good.

OK. Showtime! Let's record!



RECORD: Describe what you'll do in the video step by step. Describe your actions. Summarize what you'll say.

IDEAS:



How does the recipient feel about receiving the box?

What backstory (history) can the recipient tell so the viewer understands?

What can we tell about the box? What's on it? How it's packaged?

Is there a note inside? From whom? How does the recipient react? Is there history to tell?

What can the recipient say about each item as it's unboxed to show what you've learned?

Is there something missing that the recipient expected?

What does the recipient want to do now that they've opened the box?

Does the recipient want to send something back to the sender now?
